OR

November 2, 2018 10 am – Deliver Entry Forms, Fees, and Entries (product) directly to the Contest Coordinator between 9 – 10 am

ENTRY FEE: \$10 per entry

Entries will not be considered unless accompanied by full remittance. Wisconsin State Fair reserves the right to reject, accept or conditionally accept any entry or late entry from any exhibitor.

HONEY AND RELATED PRODUCTS CONTEST RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1) An entry form and fee of \$10 for each entry must be submitted for competition.
- 2) **Eligibility:** Entries must be produced by the exhibitor.
- 3) **Entry Requirements:**
 - There are no entry limits per class.
 - Entries should be submitted without labels attached (except as noted). Labels may be included with shipping for product display post judging.
- 4) **Delivery of Entry Form, Registration Forms, Fees, and Entries (product):**

Option 1: Ship Entry Form, Registration Form, Fees, and Entries
Entries must be shipped PREPAID. C.O.D. shipments will not be accepted. Entries must arrive before 4:30 pm on the day of delivery. Securely wrap or package entries to ensure safe delivery. **Ship product on or before October 26, 2018.** Please note: payment by credit card is NOT available.

Option 2: Deliver Entry Form, Registration Form, Fees, and Entries (product):
Directly to the contest Coordinator, Mary Kettlewell, on **Friday, November 2nd between 9 - 10 am.**
Please note: payment by credit card is NOT available.
- 4) All honey and related products entered become property of Wisconsin State Fair. Prize winning product may be on display during the 2019 Wisconsin State Fair, August 1 – 11.

5) **Judging:**

- Failure to conform to any part of the class description shall be reason for disqualification or down scoring of entry.
- The Contest Coordinator or Judge may re-categorize, disqualify, or remove entries as necessary.
- A qualified Judge/Judge(s) will evaluate and score each entry using the American Judging Scoring System.
- Products are judged based on defects by deducting points from a 100-point scale. There will be no ties. The judge's decision is final.
- Copies of individual score sheets will be provided to exhibitors in a timely manner after the judging. Official contest results will be posted on Wisconsin State Fair's website (www.wistatefair.com).

Best of Division Award: A plaque presented by Wisconsin State Fair and a complimentary one-year membership (October 1st – September 30th) in the Wisconsin Honey Producers Association presented by the **Wisconsin Honey Producers Association**.

The **Wisconsin Honey Producers Association** sponsors the Best of Show Award selected by the Judge from the Best of Division winners.

Division 1: Liquid Honey (extracted)

Quality honey, containing no more than 18.6% moisture content (higher moisture percentages will be disqualified), packed in a one (1) lb. Queen Line or Classic glass jar fitted with appropriate metal or plastic lid. The PFUND scale will be used to determine categorization of entry into classes. Each entry must consist of four (4) jars.

Division 2: Creamed Honey

Smoothly granulated, spreadable light honey, packed in a one (1) pound Round Chunk honey jar (small shoulder) or straight cylinder glass jar fitted with appropriate metal or plastic lid. Entry must consist of four (4) jars.

Entry to consist of four (4) comb sections, each sealed in its own container.
